Directions

From Austin

- **IH-35 - North** on IH-35. Exit 250 and turn left under the Hwy on Wells Branch Parkway. Go west to FM 1325 (aka Burnet Road.) Turn right on FM1325 and go north 1.4 miles to Shoreline Drive. Turn right into the parking lot.
- **Mopac (Loop 1) - Mopac** north to the end of the expressway. Mopac becomes FM1325 after Parmer Ln. Continue 2.6 miles past Parmer Lane on FM1325 to Shoreline Drive Turn right onto Shoreline drive into parking lot.

From Williamson County and all points North

- **IH-35 South.** Exit 247 turn right onto SH45 west for .7 miles. To FM1325. Turn Left onto FM1325 and go south for 1.5 miles to Shoreline Drive. Turn left into parking lot.
